Scholarship Guidelines and Criteria

1. The applicant must demonstrate strong academic achievement with a 3.0 G.P.A. or better and must submit a copy of the following documents:
 - Unofficial HS transcript with class ranking and class size
 - NM HS Competency Exam results
 - NM HS Assessment
 - ACT and/or SAT scores
2. The applicant must submit a completed scholarship application (only typed applications will be considered).
3. The applicant must submit a typed essay (double spaced, no longer than one page in length) detailing their plans for attending college and how the scholarship will help them achieve their educational goals.
4. The applicant must submit two letters of recommendation written by a schoolteacher, staff, or administrator.
5. The applicant must have an interest in pursuing a college degree.
6. The applicant must be a graduating senior from an accredited high school in the State of New Mexico.
7. The applicant must be planning to enroll into a college or university of their choice in the State of New Mexico as a full-time student (12 or more semester hours/credits).
8. The NMASBO scholarship is available to everyone with no emphasis placed on ethnicity or gender.
9. The NMASBO scholarship will be \$1500. A scholarship committee will select seven to ten applicants to be awarded.
10. The scholarship will be made payable to the student *and* the college or university upon verification of enrollment.
11. The scholarship will be forfeited if the student does not become a full-time student in the 2010 fall semester.
12. If applications submitted do not meet the above criteria, the application will be rejected.
13. Applications must be submitted to the selection committee and postmarked no later than **March 15, 2010**. Please send all application materials to:
